Context

As technologies can be considered independently of the domain of application, we believe that creating a contributory platform providing some structured information about technologies could be of common general interest at governmental and industrial level, both national and international.

There are some parameters strategists need to understand about technology (definition, strength, weaknesses, readiness, etc) independently of the industry they work for.

We believe in the creation of a level of information that can be shared; that the sensitive and confidential aspects are how technology is used and the decisions that derived from it, but not necessarily the information on technology itself.

The armasuisse Science and Technology (S+T) Foresight Program anticipates and gets the necessary understanding of the emerging technologies. This is a continuous process which increasingly considers dual-use technologies as well as their combinations. To perform this task, the Foresight Program has sponsored a technology platform that could be considered as the 'available heritage' to build the vision.

This Tiers-Lieu for the development of a contributory technology platform takes place to better understand and identify the needs, the stakeholders and the way forward towards its realization.
